EXTRACTION METHOD:

1. Prepare extraction solution by squeezing concentrate to fill 1 oz. mark and mix per every 2 gallons of water.
2. Extract carpet.
3. Use pile grooming brush to brush the fibers in the direction of the natural grain of the carpeting.

BONNET CLEAN TRAFFIC LANE AREAS:

1. Mix ¼ (8 oz.) of this bottle (as marked), into a pump-up type sprayer per each gallon of water.
2. Spray directly onto bonnet pad and saturate one side completely. When one side is loaded-up, turn the pad over and repeat spraying. When using the spray method on bonnet pads, never attempt to do sections larger than 12' x 12' at one time.
3. Alternative immersion method: Immerse bonnets in the same dilution, using a bucket and wringer. Turn and change the bonnets frequently.

SPOTTING:

1. Squeeze bottle to fill 1 oz. mark and pour concentrate into 32 oz. bottle.
2. Spray directly onto spots and let set for 5 to 10 minutes.
3. Gently agitate with small hand brush, working from the center out, with short turning strokes or using a clean white cloth.
4. Rinse with water, using a sponge and trigger sprayer.
5. Blot with an absorbent cloth or paper towels.
